We understand this is a difficult, disconcerting, and unprecedented time for all of us. With many of our lives drastically changed in this last month, your Student Government has taken the necessary steps to adjust and act accordingly to respond to the immediate needs of our student body.

Both the DMSB and CSSH pages have general information for students in any college to receive some answers to questions regarding COVID-19 and Pass/Fail. Additionally, the form to elect courses Pass/Fail can be found [here](#) on the Registrar's website. Please note, however, this Pass/Fail Policy will not be applied to courses taken in Summer I or Summer II. With all this said, the Student Government has received a considerable number of concerns and is aware of circulating student petitions ([P/F for ALL SP20 Petition](#) and [Deadline Extended for P/F Petition](#)) to further expand the current Pass/Fail Policy.

While the implications of the current Pass/Fail Policy may be substantial for some, others feel that these changes are not enough. SGA is suggesting two changes to the existing policy:

1. Extend the current deadline for students to select pass/fail courses to a date after final grades are released to students
2. Expand the University's Pass/Fail Policy to encompass all courses that a student is taking during the Spring 2020 semester
